

## **Uploading EPR Test Results to UMLearns**

**UHN Learner Registration** 


As of Wednesday June 14<sup>th</sup> 2017, we have introduced functionality that will allow for a Learner to automatically upload their EPR Test type and validation date to UMLearns upon successful completion of the EPR training and test.

This functionality is currently available for the **EPR for Providers' tests ONLY**, for both with and without MOE/MAR. (The screenshots below depict the Providers with MOEMAR updates, but same changes have been made to the Providers without MOEMAR eLearning and test)






The Declaration Form has been updated to reflect TRI. This form will only appear once a Learner has successfully completed their EPR training and test.



This page will still function as currently designed - an email will be auto-generated upon submission, one sent to the Digital Education Database and another to the Learner — this will be the 'proof of completion' should results need to be input manually in UMLearns by a UMLearns Administrator

This is the net new page introduced to the EPR test, and it will only appear once a Learner has successfully submitted the Declaration Form

EPR with MOEMAR update for Residents, Fellows, Medical Students, Nurse Practitioner Learners and Physician Assistant Learners:




EPR without MOEMAR update for Residents, Fellows, Medical Students, Nurse Practitioner Learners and Physician Assistant Learners:



Once the Learner clicks the UMLearns Logo, it will open UMLearns in a new tab within the same browser. This is where the Learner will input their UMLearns account credentials:




Upon clicking Log On, the Learner's EPR test type and Validation Date will be automatically uploaded to the Learner's My Profile in UMLearns. The Learner will only see the following:



At this point, the Learner has successfully uploaded their results and no further action is required

If a Learner did not complete their UMLearns registration before completing their EPR training and test, their results cannot be automatically uploaded to UMLearns.

In these instances, a UMLearns Administrator would request 'proof of completion' from the Learner or from Digital Education. The 'proof of completion' would come from the autoemail generated once a Learner has submitted their Declaration from after successfully completing the EPR test:



Once the UMLearns Administrator has validated the learner's successful completion of EPR training and testing, they would log into UMLearns and manually select the Learners (i) EPR Test Type and (ii) Valid until date from the drop downs in the Learner's *My Profile > Network Log-In* tab:
